Text Appearance Is the text resizable without assistive technology up to 200 percent without loss of content or functionality? Is there a line height of at least 1.5 x the font size? Is there spacing following paragraphs of at least 2 x the font size? Is there letter spacing of at least 0.12 x the font size? Is there word spacing of at least 0.6 x the font size? Is there a contrast of at least 4.5:1 (regular text) and 3:1 (large text) for large text between the text color and background color? Is there semantic markup for the content (visual differentiation between headings, captions, hyperlinks, etc)? Are textures/images/backgrounds removed that would make the text illegible? Do you utilize simple, clean fonts (where every letter is distinguishable from another {ex: serif fonts})? Visual Elements (images, graphics only) Do informative images have appropriate alternative text (under 140 characters)? Do functional images have appropriate alternative text (under 140 characters)? If alternative text is not available, is there a text description of the image in the caption or in the following text? Are complex images described textually or verbally? **Audio Description** Is there audio description available? Does the audio description describe only what is physically happening? Does the audio description meet quality requirements (Accurate, Prioritized, Consistent, Appropriate, and Equal)? UI/UX Considerations (for Apps^, Video Games*, Websites°) Is it navigable by a screen reader or are there text-to speech options available?^*° Is there the option to change the color contrast of elements?^*° Is there the option for non-visual focus cues (sound, haptic feedback, etc.)?* Are option titles/descriptions unique and descriptive? (no duplicates, semantically legible)?^*° For captions, can the user customize the size, font, or color for their legibility?^*° Is there the option for voice recognition?^*° Is there the option to navigate by keyboard or controller only?*° **Physical Media** Is there a braille version available? Is there a large-text version available?
